1. Background & Problem Statement

Rural communities in Kenya face limited access to internet connectivity and ICT infrastructure, leading to exclusion from digital opportunities. Many schools and community centers lack computers, internet, and digital training programs.

Organizations working in Kenya have shown that providing ICT equipment and training improves education systems, healthcare digitization, and economic empowerment.

Without intervention:

- Youth remains unemployed

 - Students are excluded from e-learning
 - Communities miss access to essential online services
